Fun starts at farm gate

CRUDEN Farm has long been Dame Elisabeth Murdoch's sanctuary, but this weekend she's opening the gates to the public.

Visitors to Discovery Day at Cruden Farm will get to see the famous avenue of lemon scented gums, as well as pony rides, face painting, roving entertainers, animal farm, market stalls, sports clinics and a variety of family-oriented activities.

There will also be a special performance by popular children's entertainer Justine Clarke and stage shows by Active Kidz, The Kazoos and DJ Southwick.

Tickets can be bought at the gate. Adults are \$40, while entry for children is free.

It's the sixth year Dame Elisabeth has hosted the Discovery Day, which raises money for child health research projects at the Murdoch Children's Research Institute.
