Award Details

The MCRI PSA Award for Student Travel is available to assist enrolled MCRI Doctoral or Masters by research candidates with conference registration, accommodation and travelling expenses at a national or international conference.

Applicants must be presenting an **oral presentation, paper or poster** at an interstate or overseas conference. The travel award will be provided on the condition that the abstract is accepted. If the abstract is not accepted (after the *PSA Award for Student Conference Travel* is successful) the funding will be allocated to another student.

These awards will be judged by senior MCRI researchers.

Three awards (\$500 each) will be offered in 2007 (closing dates will be in March, July and November). *Please note: successful applicants in one round of applications will not be eligible to apply in subsequent rounds in the same year.*

Application Requirements

Applicants must:

1. complete the attached application form.
2. attach the following documents:
 - a) abstract submitted to the conference.
 - b) CV

Please note that CVs must adhere to the following guidelines:

- Maximum **ONE PAGE**
 - Include the following information only:
 - (i) contact details
 - (ii) details of education
 - (iii) awards or prizes
 - (iv) previous seminar/ conference presentations
 - (v) scientific discipline experience, including membership of societies and committees
 - (vi) publications
- c) written confirmation of acceptance of the paper/ poster into the conference or invitation to present at the conference (please note that if confirmation is not available at the time of applying for this Award, confirmation of acceptance must be presented before the funding can be allocated to the student).
3. save the application form and all attachments as **ONE** document.
